The Audition Process

1. Read through this form COMPLETELY.
2. Practice the song that you would like to sing for your audition and be prepared to sing the others as we will choose one for you to sing as well. Also be prepared to read all scenes. You do not need to memorize anything. You can use your packet during the auditions. The singing and acting auditions will take place on Tuesday.
3. You will learn a dance routine as part of the auditions. The dance audition will take place on Wednesday
4. The auditions will take place on December 16th and 17th from 4:30-6:00pm. On Wednesday, please wear clothing you can dance in. Tennis shoes or jazz/ballet shoes only. Please bring a full bottle of water to both days.
5. Bring your audition form filled out to your audition.
6. Everyone that auditions will receive a part in the show.
7. Results will be posted online. An email will be sent out when the results are posted.

*Remember, we may ask you to sing & read for another character other than the one you choose, so be familiar with all audition songs and scenes.

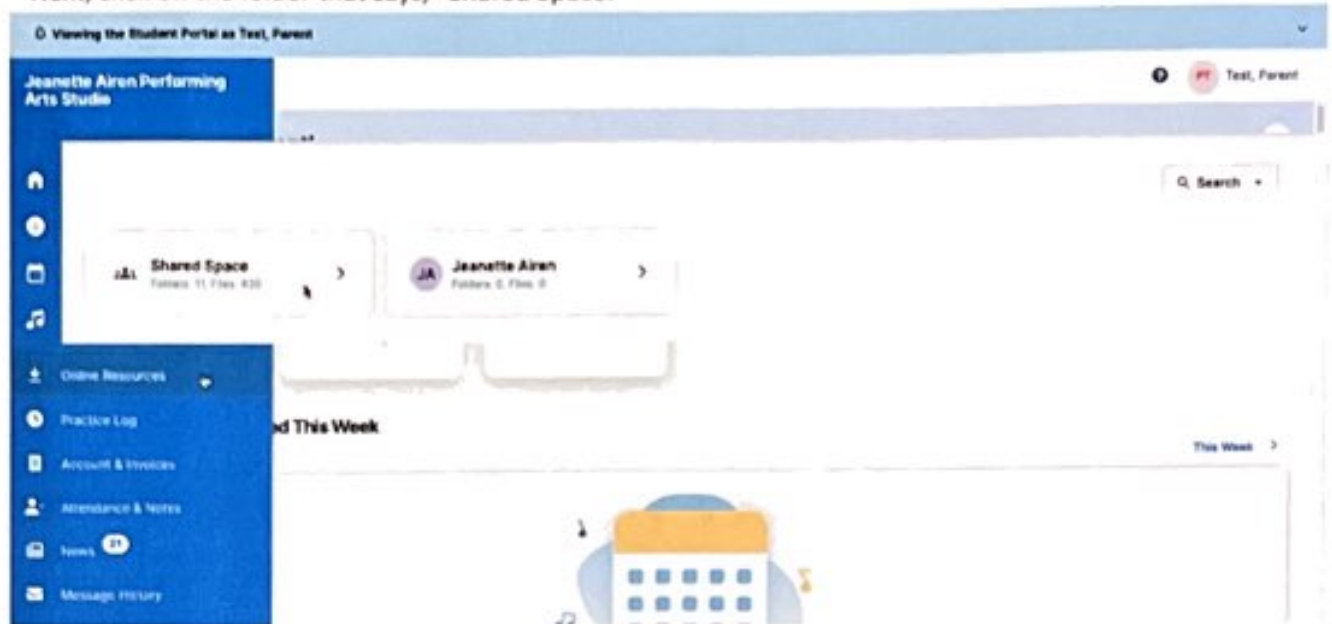
How to access the rehearsal materials:

Go to jeanetteairenstudio.com and click on the "Student Login" button at the top of any page on our website.

from *Finding Nemo KIDS*

(MARLIN follows DORY all around the stage. After a few moments, she gets suspicious when she notices someone following her.)

DORY

Do you MIND?

(MARLIN, confused, catches up to DORY.)

MARLIN

What?

DORY

I'm trying to swim here!

MARLIN

But... we're trying to find Nemo. You were showing me which way the boat went!

DORY

A boat! I've seen a boat! Follow me!

(DORY takes a big breath and begins to swim again.)

DORY

LA LA LA LA LA...

MARLIN

(interrupting)

No! We already did this!

DORY

We did? Oh dear. I have short-term memory loss. I forget things almost instantly. It runs in my family... or at least, I think it does. ...Where is my family?

(DORY forgets who MARLIN is again.)

...Can I help you?

MARLIN

Ugh!! You're wasting my time. I have to find my kid!

DORY

Meeko?

MARLIN

Nemo!

AUDITION SIDE – Crush, Marlin, Dory
from *Finding Nemo* KIDS

(MARLIN is asleep. CRUSH, a large sea turtle, wakes him)

CRUSH

Dude... Dude???

MARLIN

(woozy)

What happened?

CRUSH

He lives! You took on the jellies, mini-man. Ya saved little blue!

MARLIN

Little blue?! Dory! Is she okay?

(DORY enters playing with the SEA TURTLE KIDS)

DORY

Catch me if you can!

MARLIN

(swimming frantically in circles)

Dory! Wait! We've gotta get out of here! We've gotta get to Sydney! Where are we?

CRUSH

You're on your way, Jellyman. You're riding the East Australian Current!

NEMO

C'mon, Dad!

(MARLIN follows NEMO.)

MARLIN

Slow down, Nemo!

NEMO

Woohoo! First day of school! First day of school!

(NEMO spies the other kids playing.)

Can I go play? Please, Dad?

MARLIN

Hang on a minute; let me ask the other parents where you're supposed to be.

(to TAD, SHELDON, and PEARL's PARENTS)

Excuse me, is this where we meet the teacher?

AUDITION SIDE – Nemo, Gurgle, Peach, Bloat, Bubbles, Nigel
from *Finding Nemo KIDS*

NEMO

(frightened)
Ahhh!!! I wanna go home!

GURGLE

Feek! Stranger! Stranger in the tank!

PEACH

Stop that, you're scaring the poor thing! It's okay, honey.

NEMO

Where am I?

BLOAT

Welcome to the Sydney Harbour Aquarium! I'm Bloat. That's Peach, Gurgle, and Bubbles.

BUBBLES

Bubbles! *(Hello!)*

PEACH

Bubbles really likes bubbles. We all live here together in this tank.

NEMO

Oh. I'm Nemo. I'm from the Great Barrier Reef... in the ocean.

GURGLE

The ocean?! Ahh! Germs!!

(GURGLE cowers behind a plant.)

NIGEL

I saw Professor Sherman's boat docked in the harbor this morning, and I figured we might have a newcomer to the tank!

NEMO

I swam away at the Drop-Off and this diver in a mask came out of nowhere.

PEACH

Oh dear, you must have been so frightened.

NEMO

I have to get back to the Reef! I have to find my dad.

NIGEL

I'm afraid the Great Barrier Reef's a few thousand kilometers from here. But I'll keep a look out for your dad, Nemo.
