Chorus Instructions

Please read before beginning at-home practice.

Welcome to chorus with Mrs. Jeanette Airen Impala! We are going to have a fun year singing and making music together.

This packet includes materials for our school concert and the All District Chorus Festival for this semester.

How to Practice

1. First, listen to the song to become familiar with it.
2. After listening a few times, begin singing along.
3. Once your child feels confident singing, they may begin practicing the dance movements using the videos provided.

Materials

- Kinder Chorus students do not need to bring their packet to chorus class. The packet is for the parents to use during at home practice time.
- Extra copies can be downloaded from the chorus website and printed at home.

Chorus Class Procedures

- I will pick the students up from the Kindergarten drop off location.
- If your child has a snack, they can eat it while we wait for everyone to arrive.
- I will walk all kinder students to the MPR.

Dismissal

- After-school care students will be sent to the child care building first.
- All other students will be walked to the front of the school for parent pick-up.
- Students must be picked up on time. Mrs. Jeanette teaches at her studio after chorus and cannot stay late.
- Late pick-ups will be sent to the office. Repeated late pick-ups may result in removal from the program.

Performances

All students are invited to perform at the All District Chorus Festival at the Thousand Oaks Civic Arts Plaza. More information will be sent home soon.

All students are expected to perform in our school chorus concert (see attached schedule).

If your child cannot perform, please let me know as soon as possible. They may still participate in class, but adjustments will need to be made for the show.
