Chorus Instructions

Please read this before beginning your at home practicing.

Welcome to chorus with Mrs. Jeanette Airen Impala! We are going to have a lot of fun singing and making music together this school year. Included in this packet, you will find the materials for the musical we will be performing in chorus this semester. The Kinder chorus will be performing 3 songs for our show plus the opening song and finale song which will be sung by all choruses.

PRACTICING PROCEDURE

You can find our chorus songs on the chorus website, www.JeanetteAirenStudio.com/Chorus. Songs will be added and updated as our practice videos are made. Your child can listen to the songs or watch the videos to sing and dance with. If you choose to use the videos instead of listening to the recordings, please make sure your child is singing along and not just doing the movements. We need to make sure they know the words to the songs.

MATERIALS

Your child DOES NOT need to bring their chorus packet to class. You can keep it at home and parents can use it to help your child learn the words for our songs. If you need a second copy of this packet for any reason, it can be downloaded from the chorus website and you can print a new copy yourself.

CHORUS CLASS PROCEDURES

Miss Jeanette will pick up the kinder kids from Gate 4 when they are done with school and walk them to the MPR for Chorus Class. Backpacks should be left in the designated area when they arrive. We will ask the kids to use the bathroom before class starts. When chorus is over, Mrs. Jeanette will excuse the kids that attend after school child care first. Then, her assistant, Miss Bells, will bring the rest of the kids to be picked up by a parent or guardian in front of the school while Miss Jeanette prepares for the Senior Chorus kids to arrive in the MPR. Please understand that the Senior Chorus class is after Kinder chorus on Wednesdays, so we cannot stay late with children that are not picked up on time. Students that are not picked up on time will be taken to the office. If a student is not picked up on time multiple times, they may be removed from the chorus program.

PERFORMANCES

All chorus students are expected to perform in our performances of BACK TO THE MUSIC. If your child is not able to perform in the show, please let me know as soon as possible. They can still participate in the chorus class but I will need to adjust or change things for our performance. Admission to our mini-musical performance will be \$5 per ticket for all audience members. The lab fees and ticket sales help to pay for the expenses of putting on a musical productions, such as costumes, sets and props as well as additional staff that may be needed for our performances. Since kinder chorus members were not charged a lab fee, you will be responsible for providing your child's costume for the show. I list of costumes needs for each child will be sent home ina few weeks. If the ticket fee or providing a costume is a hardship for your family, please let Miss Jeanette know and she will make accommodations for you.
